The Northern Illinois Critical Incident Stress Management (NICISM) Team is hosting the 2-day Critical Incident Stress Management Group Crisis Intervention course. The course is certified by the International Critical Incident Stress Foundation.

TOPIC: *Group Crisis Intervention*

This training will be of interest to anyone involved in emergency response and/or healthcare situations (i.e. police, fire, EMS, mental health professionals, chaplains, physicians, nurses and/or disaster workers) and wants to understand crisis intervention techniques. Those in the emergency response, spiritual support and mental health professions can all benefit from this training and learn how to assist in providing critical incident stress management services.

The program objectives will focus on group crisis intervention utilizing the 7 core components of the critical incident stress management training program accepted by the International Critical Incident Stress Management Foundation (ICISF).
